What is an Advanced Shipping Notice and Why is it Important?

An advanced shipping notice (ASN) is a collection of information in an electronic format (email, data files and access to data via APIs) that provides detailed information about a meat messaging shipment. The purpose of an ASN is to notify the receiving party (Importer of Record, customer, buyer, non-packer exporter, 3rd party cold store, import inspection facility) when shipping has been sent and provide the physical characteristics of the shipment.

The concept of ASNs can be traced back to the need for businesses to enhance communication and transparency in the shipping process.

As global trade expanded and supply chains grew more complex, there was an increasing demand for methods to keep all parties informed about shipment details. The ASN emerged as an answer to this, serving as an anticipatory document about incoming deliveries.

An ASN is not merely a notification; it's a comprehensive collection of information that details specifics about the shipment right down to the individual case barcodes. For details on what is available via the Meat Messaging ASN API look here

Furthermore, the ASN is intrinsically linked with the associated packing list and other export documents for a shipment of meat, ensuring that the contents of the shipment match the previously provided details, thereby minimizing discrepancies.

In today's digital era, the transmission of ASNs has embraced the realm of electronic data interchange (EDI). Meat Messaging has the function of ASN inbuilt and an ASN can be triggered manually by a user or automatically by API.

This method is particularly advantageous for ASNs, as it facilitates real-time updates and instant communication. By using Meat Messaging ASNs, businesses ensure that the data on the ASN remains consistent and quickly accessible to all relevant parties.

The benefits of the use of ASNs include:

- Speed and efficiency. ASNs allow for faster processing of shipments, ensuring that recipients are prepared for the incoming goods, leading to quicker unloading and warehousing.
- Enhanced communication. With the use of ASNs, suppliers and customers maintain open lines of communication. The buyer is always informed about what to expect and when leading to smoother operations.
- Accuracy and reduced errors. By correlating the ASN with the packing list, discrepancies can be spotted and addressed promptly, ensuring that errors are minimised and the receiving process remains efficient.
- Prepopulate inventory with the shipment details and support for Advanced Inventory Management by having inventory visibility at the time of shipping.

As a user of Meat Messaging, you should send the ASN either manually or automatically (via APIs) as soon as the shipment details have been uploaded to Meat Messaging.




Step 3.3:

Then check to see if the ASN was sent at the bottom of the page under Previous ASNs for this message. This is a record to show all ASN's that have been sent attached to the shipment.
